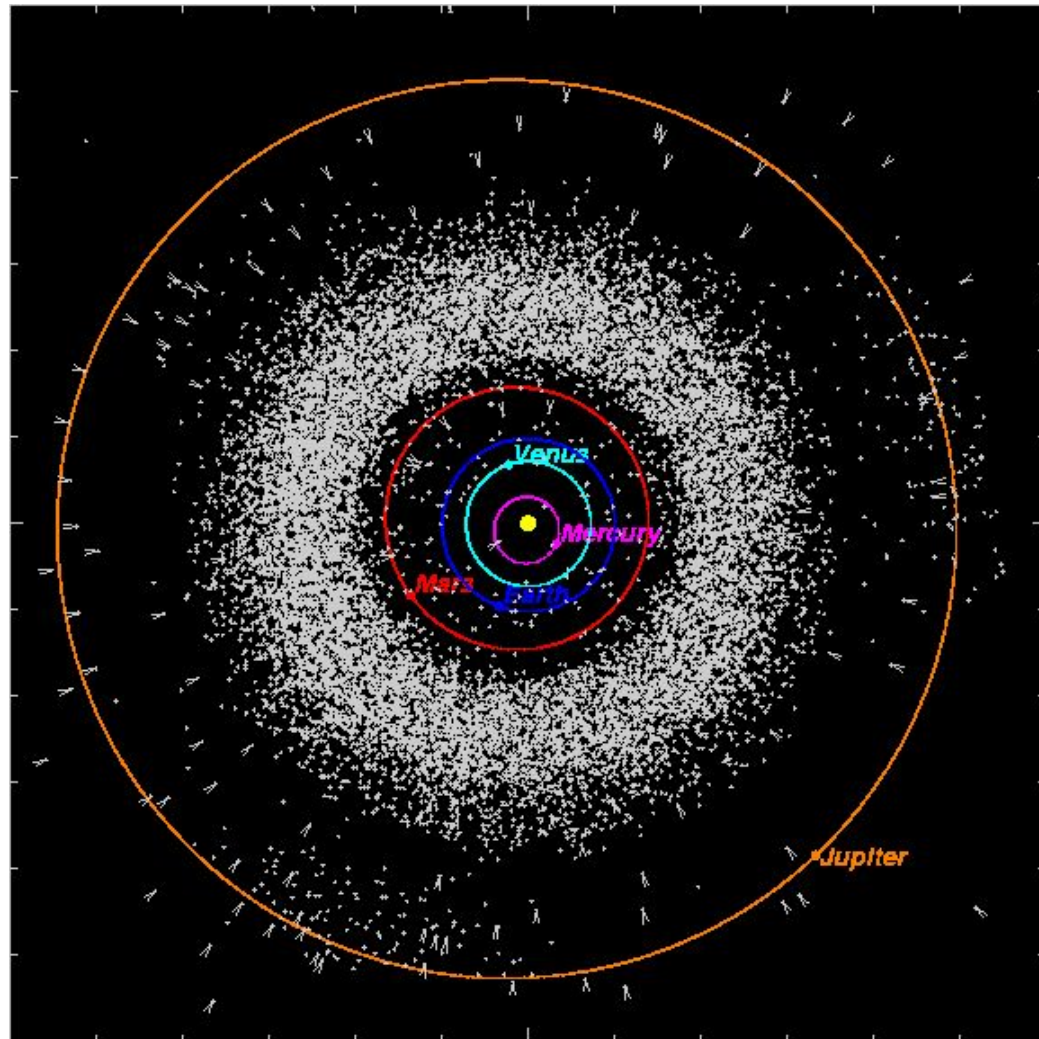
What is an asteroid?

Asteroids are small, rocky objects that orbit **the Sun**.

Where are asteroids located?

The Asteroid Belt: The majority of known asteroids orbit within the asteroid belt between **Mars** and **Jupiter**. The belt is estimated to contain **between 1.1 and 1.9 million** asteroids larger than 1 kilometer (0.6 miles) in diameter, and millions of smaller ones.

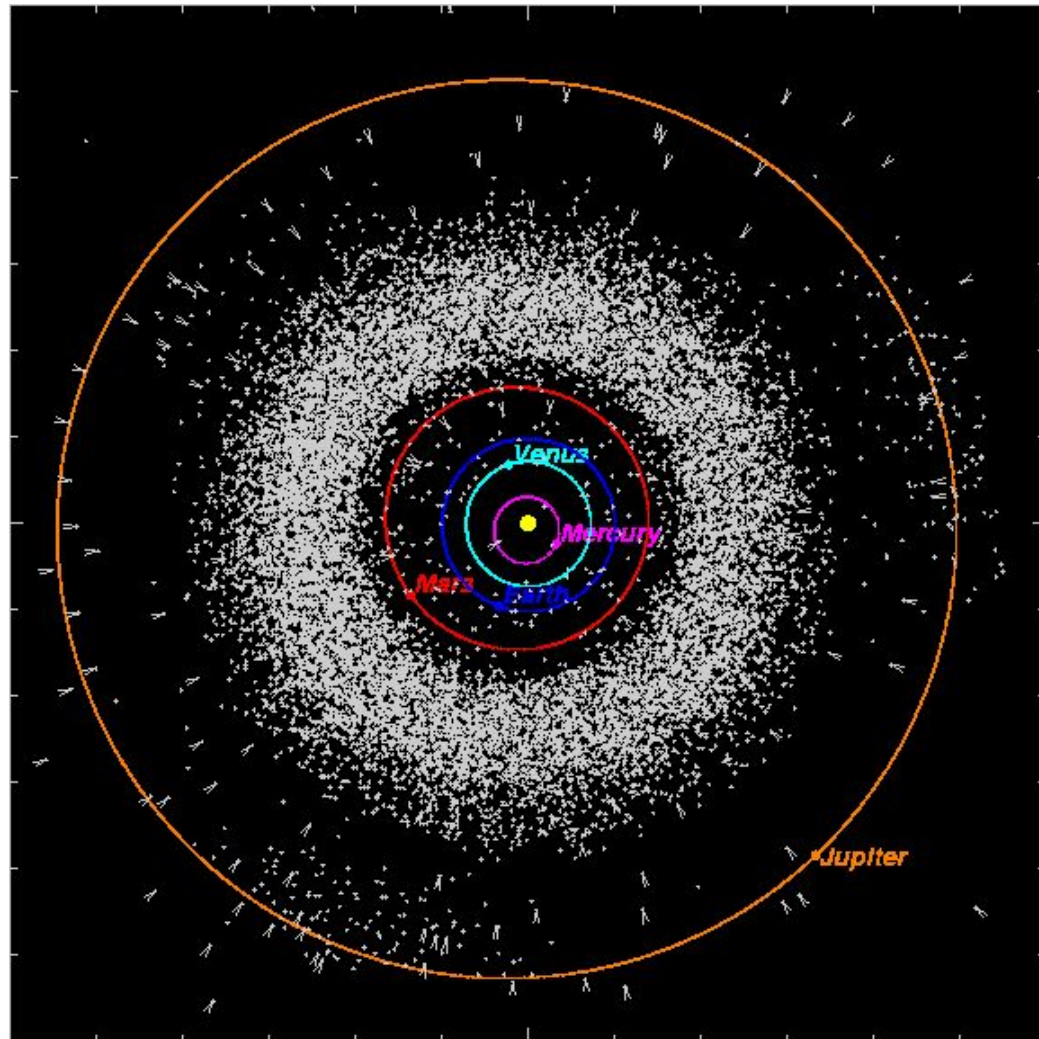

How did asteroids form?

Asteroids are leftovers from the formation of our [solar system](#) about 4.6 billion years ago. Early on, the birth of Jupiter prevented any planetary bodies from forming in the gap between Mars and Jupiter, causing the small objects that were there to collide with each other and fragment into the asteroids seen today.

The first four asteroids to be discovered

1. Ceres – January 1, 1801
2. Pallas – March 28, 1802
3. Juno – September 1, 1804
4. Vesta – March 29, 1807

1. Ceres – Sister
2. Pallas – Daughter
3. Juno – Wife
4. Vesta – Sister

4. Vesta – Sister

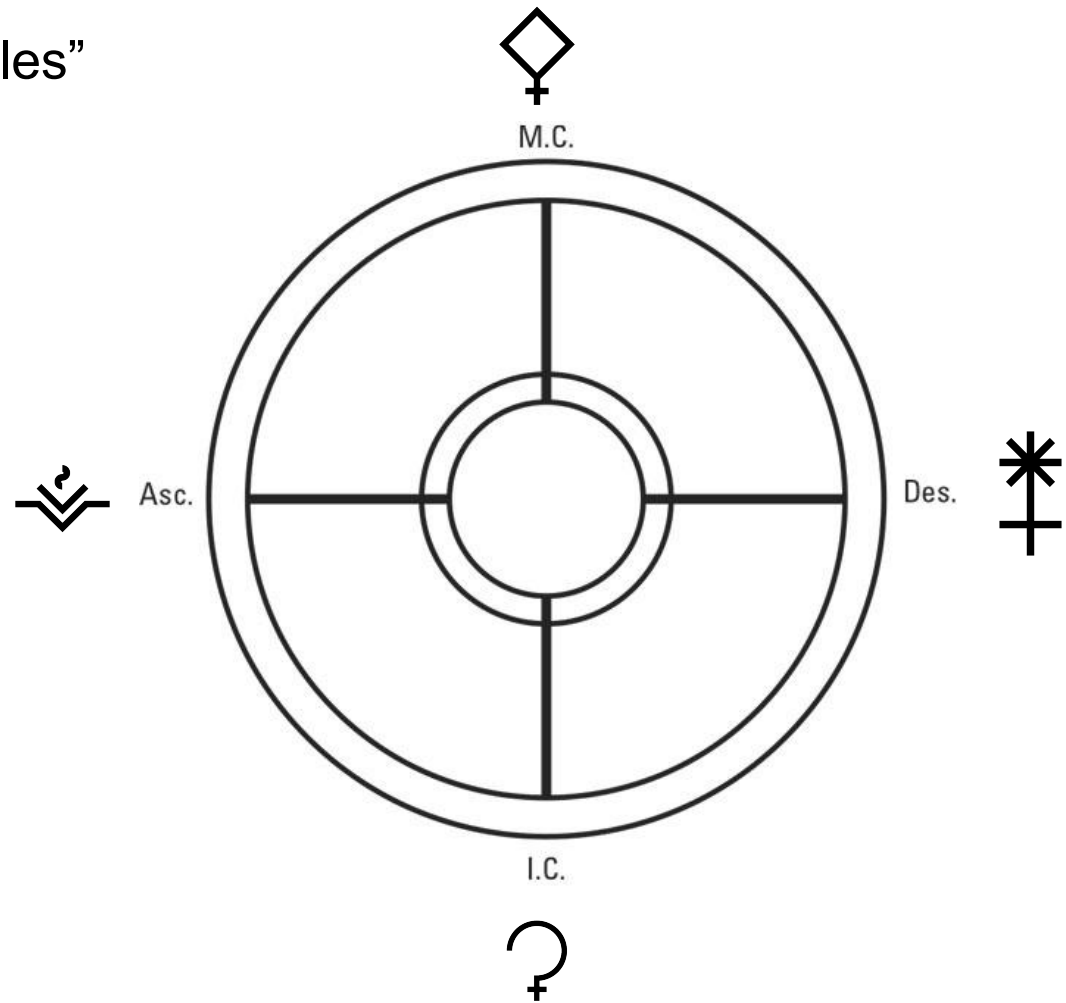
The Cardinal Cross – “The Angles”

CERES MAINTENANCE

Ceres Glyph: The glyph, or symbol, for Ceres is represented by a sickle – a short-handled farming tool with a semicircular blade, used for cutting grain, lopping, harvesting, or trimming. The shape of the Ceres is reminiscent of the Venus glyph, except 1/4 of the circle has been removed. This then becomes reminiscent of a crescent (receptivity) which is placed over the cross (matter).

Ceres Symbols:

Ears of corn, wheat, sickle, plow, poppy flower, pig, garden snake, torch, cornucopia

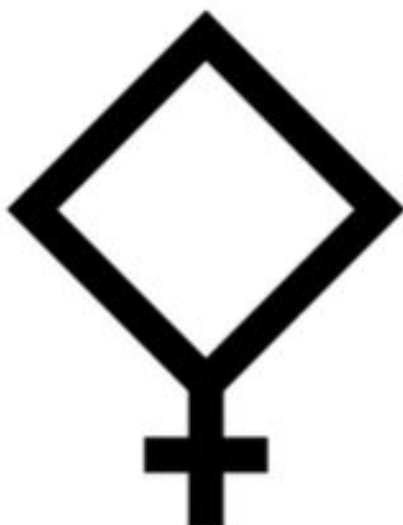


PALLAS MAINTENANCE

Pallas Glyph: The glyph, or symbol, for Pallas is a diamond placed over the cross (matter).

Pallas Symbols:

- Owl
- Serpent
- Shield
- Diamond Spier
- Olive Tree
- Head of Medusa
- Armor



JUNO MAINTENANCE

Juno Glyph: The glyph, or symbol, for Juno is a scepter – an ornamented staff carried by rulers on ceremonial occasions as a symbol of sovereignty.

Juno Symbols:

- Scepter
- Crown
- Peacock
- Cow
- Pomegranate
- Lotus
- Rainbow



VESTA MAINTENANCE

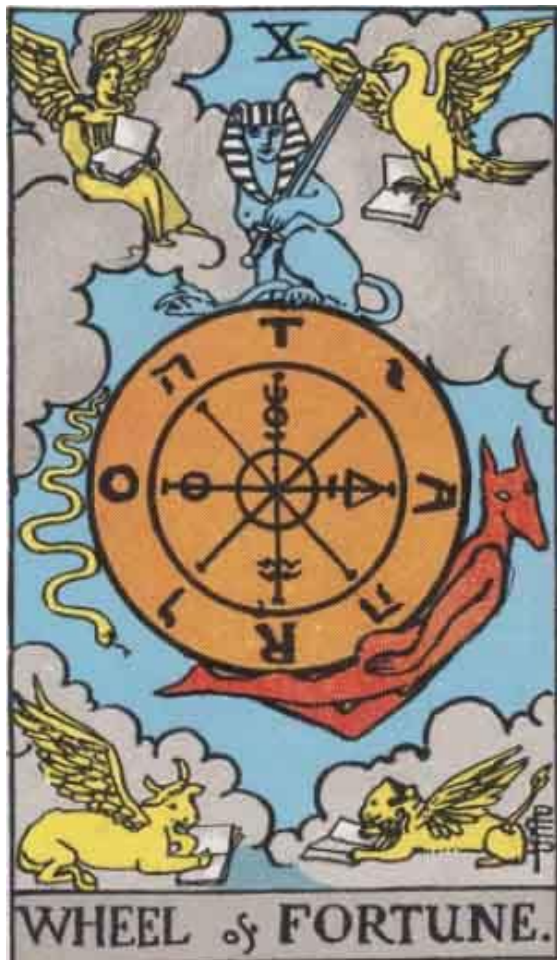
Vesta Glyph: Inside of a wide-shaped letter V with horizontal lines rests another wide-shaped V holding a sacred backwards S-shaped flame.

Vesta Symbols:

- Elements – Fire & Earth
- Oil Lamp
- Hearth Fireplace
- Eternal Flame
- The Torch
- Candles
- Ovens & Stoves
- Altar Fires
- The Donkey – **service, suffering, peace and humility.**
- Veils

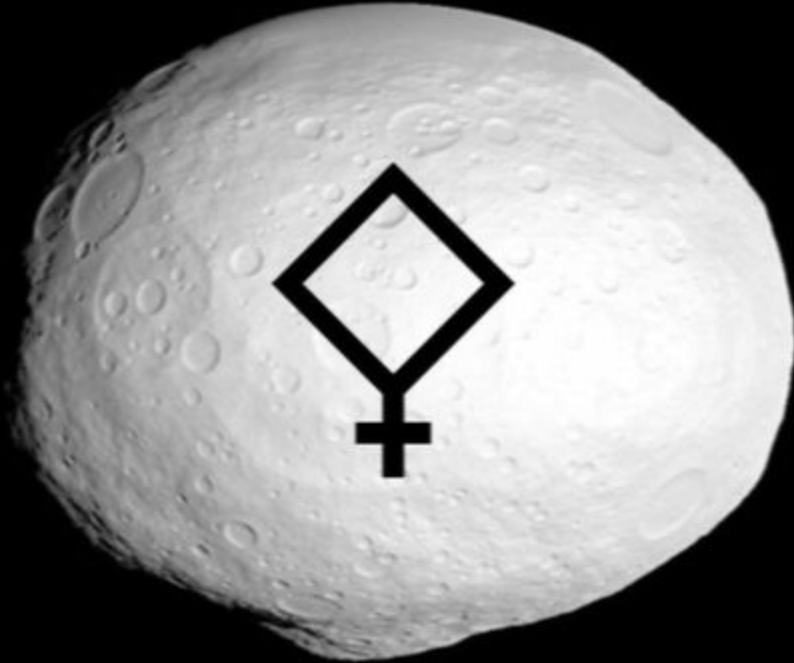
Ceres Personal Story – Jeff Hinshaw, Ceres in Sagittarius in 11th House

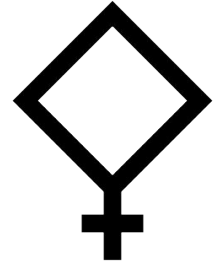

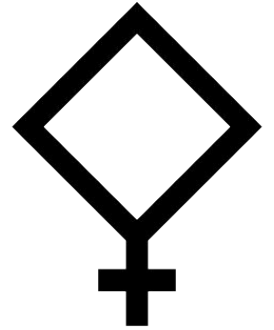
Pallas Questions for Reflection

- How might I support and sustain the growth of my spiritual callings?



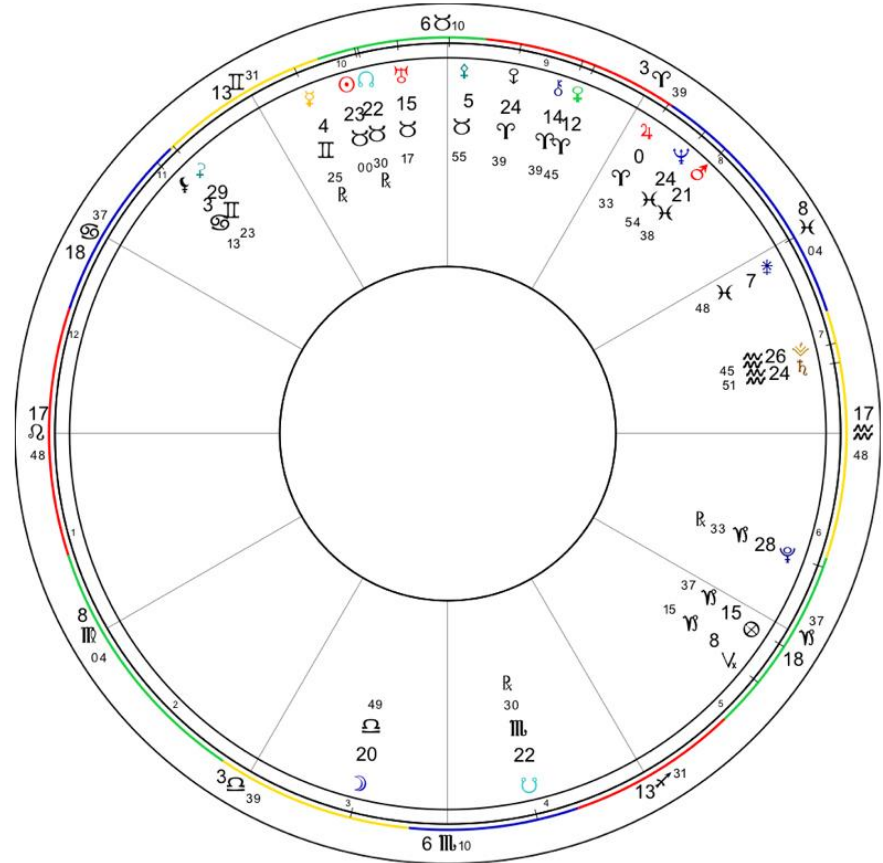

Birth Chart for this Lecture

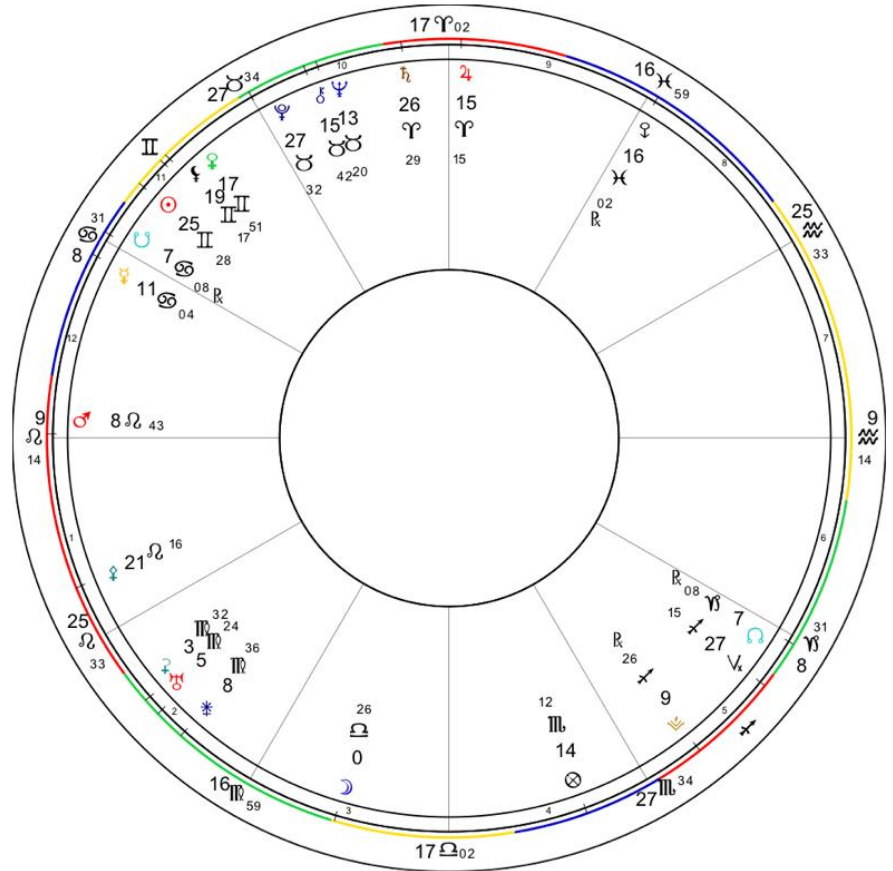

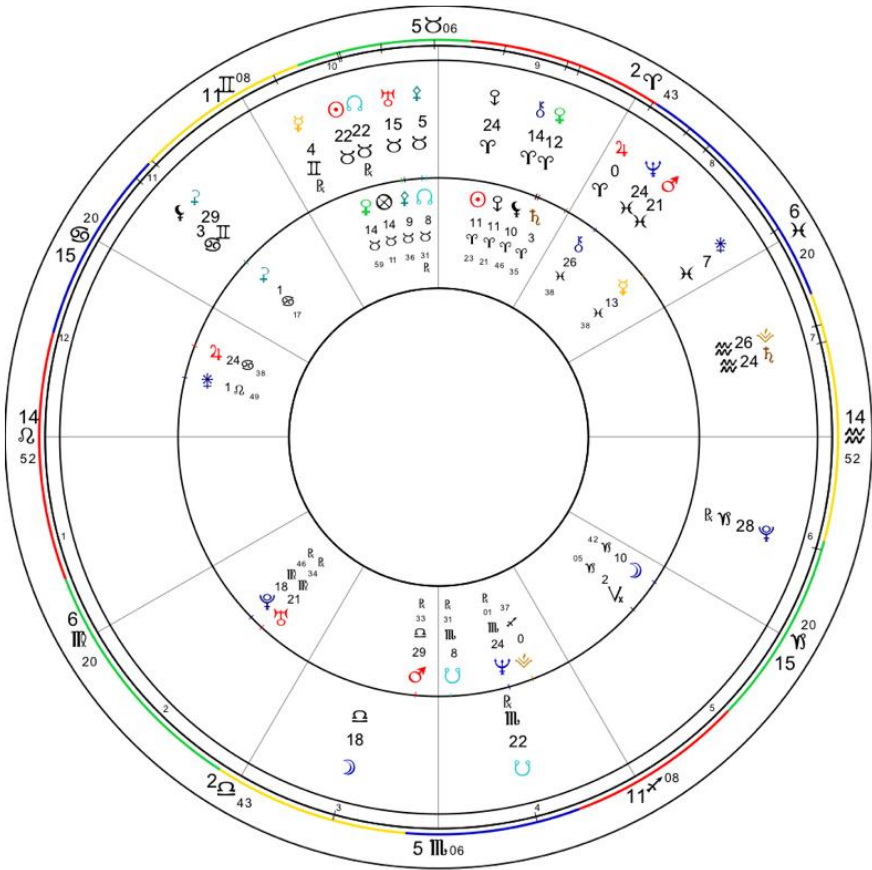
Heidi Rose Robbins' Chart

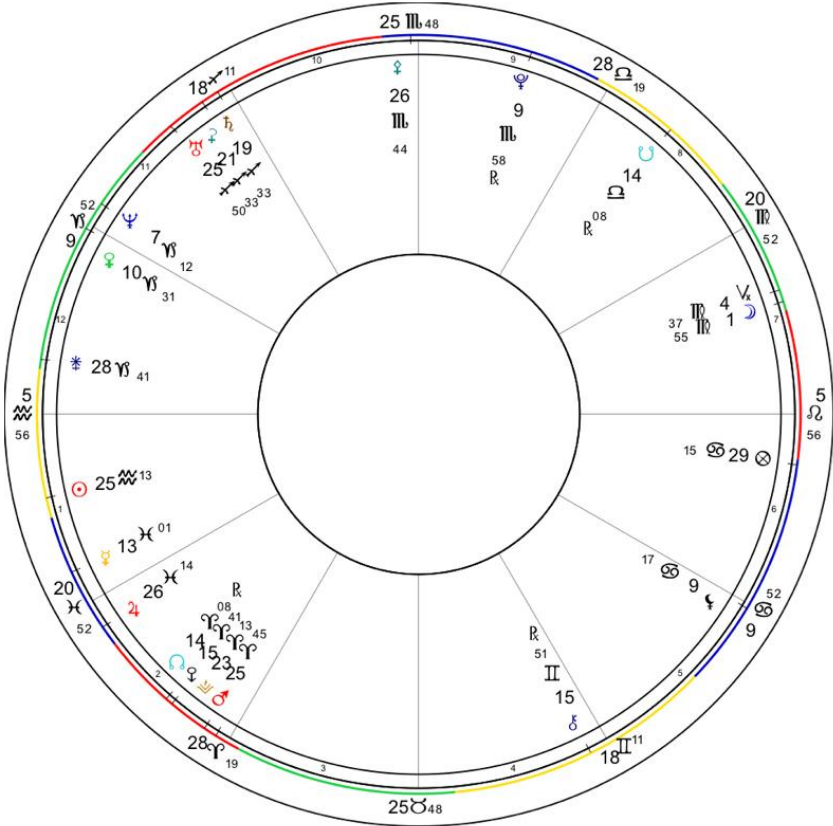
Heidi Rose Robbins' Transit Bi-Wheel Chart

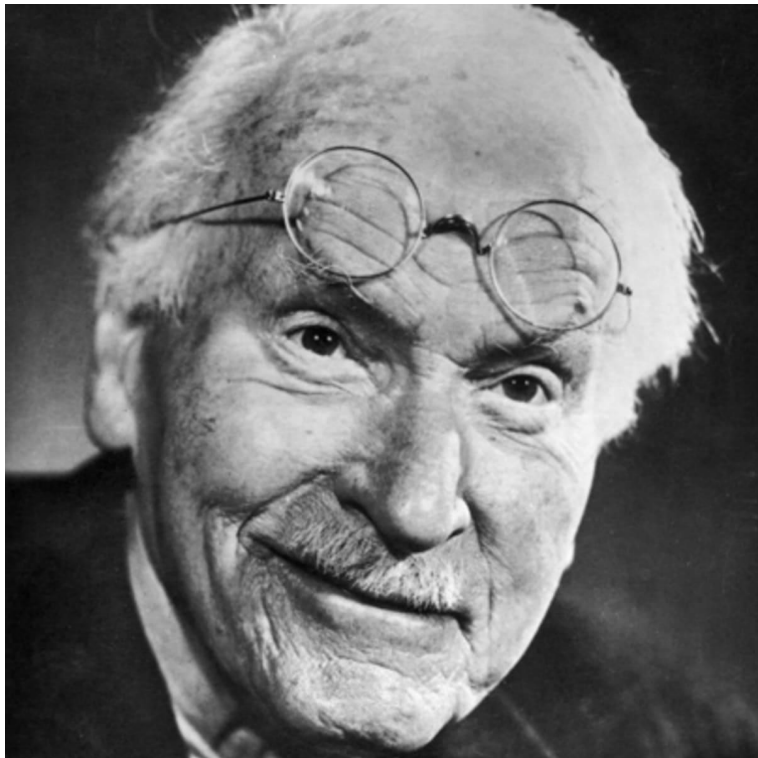

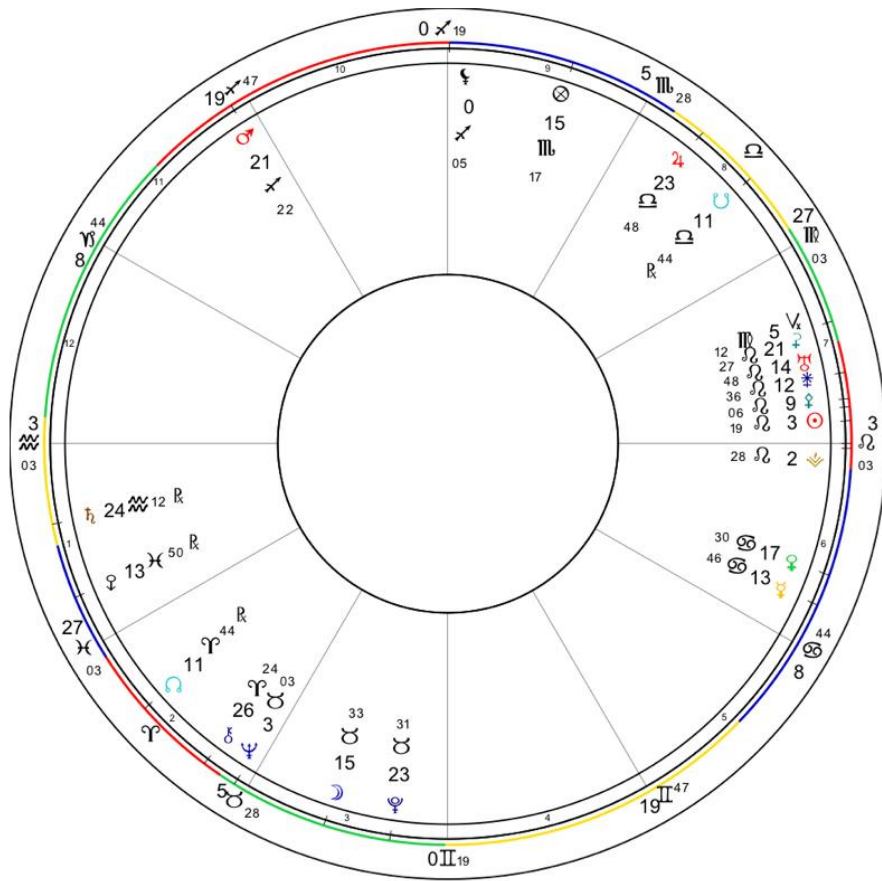
